The 32nd Annual Battersea Pumpkin Festival!

Battersea will be humming with fall fun on Saturday, October 3, 2026, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Battersea Ball Diamond & Park, 5167 Battersea Road. Come for the pumpkins and stay for family activities, live music, food, contests, rides, local vendors and community fun.

Getting Here: Parking & Shuttle Service

Parking is available at Storrington Community Centre, 3910 Battersea Road in Sunbury, and Storrington Public School, 4576 Battersea Road, just south of Battersea. There is also plenty of on-site parking at the festival grounds via Doris Smith Lane.

Free Shuttle Buses

Shuttle buses run throughout the day beginning at 10 a.m. Leave your vehicle at one of the off-site locations and ride into the festival. Thank you to Robert Hogan Bus Lines for helping provide the shuttle service.

Looking for a little extra Halloween fun? Stop by the new Haunted Tunnel at 5190 Battersea Road — and snap a picture while you're there!

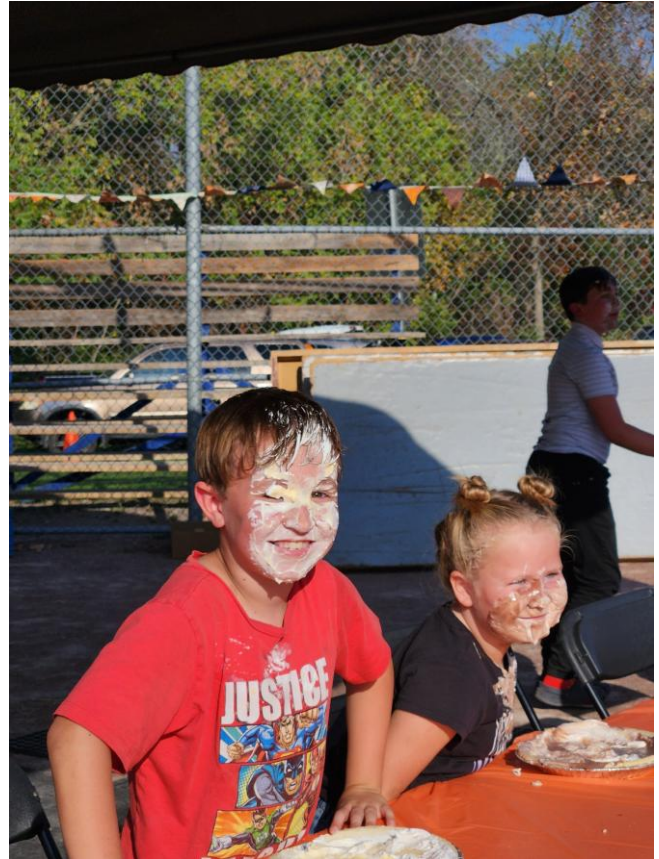
Family Games
